YOC Reopening Guidelines

July 1- July 31, 2020

- Youth on Course members ages 10 and younger must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) to assure that proper social distancing guidelines are being adhered to. It will be at the individual golf course's discretion whether the adult has to pay, if they are not playing along with the youth. One adult per foursome (if they are not playing).
- All tee times must be made in advance/over the phone at the YOC facility. **NO ONLINE TEE TIMES SHOULD BE MADE** to assure proper payment procedures are followed. Payment procedures will follow the rules at the individual facilities. *Please contact clubs in advance. Golf courses are experiencing operational changes with the current situation. YOC facilities may have revised their YOC rate availability and YOC members MUST call the course ahead of time to confirm availability and are at the courses' discretion.*

ADDITIONAL ON-COURSE GOVERNMENT-DEFINED PLAYER RESTRICTIONS:

- Any players with any symptoms of COVID-19 should not play
- In addition, any players from a household with someone with symptoms of COVID-19 should not play
- Please observe social distancing. No congregation of more than ten players at any point during your visit to the property
- It is recommended that golfers walk and carry their own clubs
- Flagsticks may not be touched
- Do not touch any rakes in the bunkers. Please smooth sand with your feet or club
- Bring your own supply of balls, tees, ball markers, and any other equipment needed to play golf
- Insist on social distancing on tees, greens, and throughout the round
- Players shall maintain adequate physical distancing between other groups
- Golfers should pick up their own ball
- Handle your own scorecard
- Bring your own water/sports drink, towel, and snack
- Do not use the public drinking fountain or ball cleaner
- Put on your golf shoes at your vehicle
- Bring hand sanitizer with you and use during your round and at the end
- No handshakes at the beginning or end of the round
