Volunteer Committee Descriptions



Volunteers are needed primarily in the morning each day. Some committees begin their work as early as 6 a.m. Most end by the mid-afternoon. Volunteers are asked to be present for at least five-to-six hours **on two days** as noted for each committee.

Player Assistants

One or Two Player Assistant/s will be stationed on each hole. Each golfer may have a caddie and or/an aide. The Player Assistant will provide additional help as needed with mobility issues, tee & spot balls, rake traps, guide spectators and provide other assistance as needed. Golf background & understanding of etiquette is preferred.

NUMBER: 25 on Saturday, 25 on Sunday (none on Friday)

TIME: 18 arrive at 8 a.m.; 7 arrive at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday
18 arrive at 7 a.m.; 7 arrive at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday

SHIFT: 6 hours (approximately)

Walking Scorers

One Walking Scorer will accompany each group of three golfers, using his/her personal cell phone to record scores for each hole, and also record the scores on a printed scorecard. It is essential to be in good physical condition with the ability to walk 18 holes keeping pace with players who may be riding in carts.

NUMBER: 30 on Saturday, 30 on Sunday (none on Friday)

TIME: 15 arrive at 8 a.m.; 15 arrive at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday
15 arrive at 7 a.m.; 15 arrive at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday

SHIFT: 6 hours (approximately)

**Practice Range &
Putting / Chipping Area**

Volunteers will monitor the practice range and putting green, admitting and assisting players (as needed), caddies and aides while keeping spectators and others at a safe distance. The members of this committee will make sure the area has plenty of golf balls.

NUMBER: 7 on Friday; 4 on Saturday & Sunday
4 arrive when range opens each day
3 arrive at 1 P.M. Friday only

RANGE OPEN: 6 a.m. – 3 p.m. Friday;
7:30 a.m. – noon Saturday;
6:30 a.m. – 11 a.m. Sunday

SHIFT: 5-6 hours

Shuttles / Parking

Direct drivers to the designated parking areas for competitors, volunteers and staff. Using six-person shuttle carts, transport players, caddies and aides (and possibly family and friends) from parking lot to registration area, practice range/putting green, first and tenth tees, and from the 9th green to the 10th tee during the round. Direct and assist spectators who arrive by shuttle bus from remote parking area. Repeat the process in reverse when the round is completed.

NUMBER: 5 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: Friday and Sunday: 3 arrive at 6 a.m.; 2 arrive at 11 a.m.

Saturday: 3 arrive at 6:30 a.m.; 2 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5-6 hours

Golf Cart Services

Volunteers will work with the Fox Bend staff to arrange carts with name plates for players, caddies, aides and officials in designated staging areas. In addition to standard two-person golf carts, there are special single-seat and adaptive golf carts that will be assigned to some players, and six-person carts used by the shuttle volunteers.

NUMBER: 6 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: 3 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5-6 hours

Player Registration / Pro-Am Registration / Caddie Services

Volunteers will register and welcome players, caddies, aides and greet spectators each day. On Friday, they will register participants in the charity pro-am events. Volunteers will be familiar with general tournament information and course layout to answer questions. Volunteers are responsible for the Caddie Bib collection and redistribution.

NUMBER: 8 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: Friday: 5 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 12 p.m.

Sunday: 5 arrive at 6 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

Saturday: 5 arrive at 6:30 a.m.; 3 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5 hours

Volunteer Registration

Volunteers will check-in volunteers, answer questions, distribute volunteer uniforms, provide meal vouchers, and keep the venue clean.

NUMBER: 4 each day, less needed if volunteer works both shifts

TIME: Friday and Sunday: 2 arrive at 6 a.m.; 2 arrive at 11 a.m.

Saturday: 2 arrive at 6:30 a.m.; 2 arrive at 11 a.m.

SHIFT: 5 hours
