CDGA KemperSports Two-Person Scramble Qualifier Reminders

- 52 teams competing across four flights. The top-two Gross and top-two Net teams in each flight will advance to the Finals at Harborside International Golf Center on Monday, September 15.
- The My CDGA app is the Official Scorecard. Players MUST enter scores after each hole and verify them after their round with CDGA staff in the scoring area on the Ballroom Terrace off #18 Green.
- Special Contests:
 - Republic Bank Aces to Provide Challenge The 9th & 17th holes are designated as \$5,000 hole-in-one split-the-pot hole challenges with \$2,500 going to the golfer making the ace and a \$2,500 donation to the CDGA Foundation (in the name of the golfer).
 - \$1,000 Tour Edge Gift Card for an ace on Hole #11
 - \$750 Zero Friction Card for an ace on Hole #4
 - Closest to the Hole
 - Closest to the holes #4, #9, and #11 will win one dozen Callaway golf balls
 - Closest to the hole #17 will win a custom wedge or putter from Callaway
 - Republic Bank Longest Putt Hole The player who sinks the longest putt on the 18th hole will win:
 - One dozen Callaway golf balls
 - Entry into World's Longest Putt Regional on September 6 at Bob Berry Sunshine Golf Course at Midwest Golf House
 - The chance to win a split-the-pot \$5,000 prize on the practice green immediately following play
- This is a two-person team scramble on each hole, both members of the team will hit a tee shot from their designated tee. The team then selects one of the tee shots and marks the spot from which to play. Both golfers then play their second strokes from that location and, again, select the ball in the best position. This method of play continues until the golf ball is holed to record the team score. When playing the next shot:
 - Not on the green ball must be played from the same condition (Fairway, First Cut, Fringe, Rough, Bunker, Penalty Area, etc..) within one club length, no closer to the hole.
 - On a putting green, only one putter head length from the mark, no closer to the hole.
- Keep up with the group of ahead of you to maintain Pace of Play.
 - Presented by:
- No minimum tee shots required.
- Range Finders are permitted & approved for use. Slope feature cannot be used.
- Men will be playing the GREEN CDGA tees. Seniors (55+ as of September 15, 2025) will be playing the WHITE CDGA tees. Women will be playing the GOLD CDGA tees.
- Bathroom Locations: Clubhouse and Halfway House near #6 & #14 Greens.
